Peter Fenner is a writer, practitioner, spiritual teacher, and founder of the Center for Timeless Wisdom. He has a Ph.D. in Buddhist philosophy and psychology, and was a monk in the Tibetan Buddhist tradition for nine years. Fenner has taught Asian philosophy and spirituality at institutes and universities for over 20 years. He is presently a senior lecturer in Philosophy and Religious Studies at Deakin University in Australia, and teaches regularly in Australia, Europe, and the United States.

This respected authority on both Eastern spirituality and Western psychology became a student of the famed Tibetan Lama Thubten Yeshe in 1975. He spent fourteen years involved in traditional structures of Tibetan Buddhism, nine of these as a monk. As a post-monastic, he explored and discovered forms through which to communicate Buddhist nondual wisdom that can be easily assimilated by psychologically sophisticated Westerners.

Fenner's books include *The Ontology of the Middle Way* (Kluwer, 1990), *Reasoning into Reality* (Wisdom Publications, 1994) and *Essential Wisdom Teachings* (with Penny Fenner (Nicolas-Hays, 2001) and *The Edge of Certainty: Dilemmas on the Buddhist Path* (Nicolas-Hays, 2002). His psychological essays have appeared in journals such as the *Journal of Contemplative Psychotherapy, Revision, Journal of the International Association for Spiritual Psychiatry, Psychologia* (Tokyo), and *3me Millenaire*.
